- John McCain returned to Jacksonville, Florida in 1973 after more than five years as a prisoner of war to find that his wife Carol was a different person. During McCain's absence, she had stayed faithful to their marriage waiting his return while taking care of their children. McCain courted and married Cindy in May 1980 -- a month after his divorce became final. Some of McCain's acquaintances aren't forgiving. They portray the politician as a self-centered womanizer who effectively abandoned his crippled wife to 'play the field'.
